## **TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. Fish must be caught in Greers Ferry Lake or its tributaries.
2. All Arkansas Game and Fish and Corp of Engineers rules apply.
3. Entrants must have a valid Arkansas fishing license, unless 15 or younger.
4. Fish must be caught on a hand-held pole.
5. Fish must be weighed in only by the contestant catching the fish.
6. Fish must be fresh and gills must be pink in color-not ash or white-not frozen or semi-frozen.
7. You can have only one fish 28 inches or over on the board at one time.
8. You cannot hold 1<sup>st</sup> place if you held 1<sup>st</sup> place the previous year.
9. You may only win largest weekly fish once during the tournament.
10. In case of a tie, first fish weighed in wins.
11. If all places are not filled, money will go toward door prizes.
12. Entries must be turned in by noon February 25<sup>th</sup>, mailed entries must be postmarked by February 24<sup>th</sup>.
13. All entries must contain a valid fishing license number or the entry will be void.
